

CERT/ARES Radio Net Script

(Directed Roll Call) (10/9/2017)

At 1925 hrs, make the following announcement:

This is [your call sign]. The Maple Valley CERT and ARES net will begin in 5 minutes. Your net control this evening is [name], [your call sign].

At 1930 hrs, make the following announcement:

Good evening, this is [name], [your call sign], your net control station for this evening.

Welcome to the combined Maple Valley CERT and Maple Valley ARES net. This net meets every Tuesday at 7:30 pm on this repeater. In case of repeater failure, we will use 147.260MHz simplex. This is an open net and all are welcome to join. If you have emergency traffic, use your call sign to break into the net at any time.

The Community Emergency Response Team meets in person the 2nd Monday of most months at 6:30 p.m. at Fire Station # 80.

The ARES Team meets in person the 4th Wednesday of most months at 7:00 p.m. at the Maple Valley EOC.

In the event of an emergency, CERT members are requested to monitor this frequency for information and possible assignment. Should this repeater become unavailable, CERT members should monitor 147.260 simplex. ARES members should monitor 146.540 simplex for information and possible assignment.

Again this is [name], your net control for tonight. I will now call for any general announcements for the net. Please come with your call sign now.

Hearing none or after announcements:

All stations please standby for weekly roll call. We will call for mobile and Echolink stations first, followed by a directed roll call. When called, please respond with your call sign and indicate if you have any traffic for the net. ARES stations should also check in via Winlink by sending a message to net control station [your call sign].

Are there any mobile stations wishing to check in, please come with your call sign now.

Are there any Echolink stations wishing to check in, please come with your call signs now.

I will now proceed with the regular roll call.

At conclusion of roll call:

Are there any missed or late check-ins? Please come with your call sign now.

Hearing none or after additional check-ins:

Are there any visitors wishing to check in? Please come with your call sign now.

This will conclude this net. Are there any stations wishing after net contact?
